Dear Minister Ryan I respectfully ask that you consider opening the river Slaney on the 1st of March 2022 as opposed to the 1st of April. I have explained some reasons for the request below in order to help you come to your decision.

- (1) Firstly I am not asking you to change the status of the river as it is already open for catch and release. I am asking you to allow a slightly earlier start.
- (2) Secondly catch and release is highly successful and the colder the water the easier it is to release fish as the oxygen level is higher in cold water.
- (3) Thirdly and of great importance to the preservation of salmon the presence of legitimate anglers on the bank keeps poachers and those who would kill fish off the bank. IFI have a difficult job and extra eyes on the bank are a great help.
