Hi,

This deposit return plan is excellent. I fully support it.

The Report recommends a centralised, operational model for Ireland. Do you agree with this recommendation?

If not, do you favour a:

- a) decentralised / financial DRS; or,
- b) hybrid.

A: It's not clear enough exactly what a centralised model will look like in practise, therefore, I suggest hybrid.

What role should waste collectors play in the operation of a DRS?

A: They could encourage and facilite the public in their return of recyclable items.

The DRS study proposes a deposit per container of €0.20. Do you think this is appropriate? If not should it be higher or lower or should different deposit rates apply depending on container size?

A: 20c seems reasonable but I can see provision for larger amounts for larger items.

Consumers need to know about a DRS long before it becomes operational – do you have any suggestions as to how best the introduction of a DRS can be communicated to the public?

A: Electronically. Please stop wasting money and impacting the environment on printing information booklets and then delivering them to all homes.
