Report of the fourth meeting of the Firearms Expert Committee.

- 1. The fourth meeting of the Firearms Expert Committee was held on 1 November 2022 at 51 St Stephen's Green. The meeting was chaired by Ms. Emma Meagher Neville.
- 2. At its fourth meeting, the Committee discussed the appropriateness of the five round limit, which is applied to most short-firearms. The Committee discussed the merits and drawbacks of the application of the limit.
- 3. The Committee began its consideration of two items in its terms of reference: whether firearms certificates should be conditioned to specify the locations where the firearm may be used; and whether firearms certificates should be conditioned to limit the use of the firearm to the purpose for which the firearms certificate was sought.
- 4. The Committee acknowledged there are many factors to be considered to insure that any conditions which are applied to a certificate are practical and appropriate. The Committee discussed how applying such conditions could interact with the different shooting pursuits such as hunting and target shooting.
- 5. The Committee again discussed the suitability of centre-fire semi-automatic rifles licenced after the 18 September 2015. The member's positions on the suitability of centre-fire semi-automatic rifles remains unchanged since the previous meeting.
- 6. The Committee agreed to meet again in late November 2022.
