Report of the fifth meeting of the Firearms Expert Committee.

- 1. The fifth meeting of the Firearms Expert Committee was held on 28 November 2022 at 51 St Stephen's Green. The meeting was chaired by Ms. Emma Meagher Neville.
- 2. At its fifth meeting, the Committee discussed the definition of an assault rifle. Representatives from the Garda National Technical Bureau, attended the meeting for the discussion of this agenda point only.
- 3. The Committee agreed that the definition of an assault rifle is a source of inconsistency in licencing decisions and it should be addressed in the report.
- 4. The Committee began its consideration of one items in its terms of reference: whether there should be a limit on the number and type of firearms a person may hold. The Committee considered whether setting a limit would be appropriate or if alternatives to a limit could be explored.
- 5. The Committee discussed the issues of the licencing of centre-fire short firearms, the five round limit and the barrel length and agreed the recommendations and positions to be reflected in the report.
- 6. The Committee discussed the regulation of gas-operated firearms which are over one joule. The Committee considered whether the licencing framework applied to these firearms is appropriate.
- 7. The Committee agreed to meet again in early December 2022.
