NATIONAL YOUTH ASSEMBLY ON CLIMATE 2022 RECOMMENDATIONS

The Programme for Government committed to the establishment of a Youth Assembly, with various modules for young people.

The interim Climate Actions 2021 made a commitment to establish a youth Climate Council as part of the new National Dialogue on Climate Action engagement model and annual Climate Action Plan consultations, to help support future dialogue with young people.

The National Youth Assembly on Climate is a core component of the National Dialogue on Climate Action. Delegates represented the Assembly at the National Climate Stakeholder Forum.

The National Youth Assembly on Climate took place online on the 2nd of March 2022. 35 youth delegates aged 12-24 years from across Ireland attended, representing youth organisations and Comhairle na nÓg (Youth Councils). The delegates attended a preparation session and then took part in a day of discussion. The Minister for the Environment, Climate and Communications, Eamon Ryan listened to and discussed the delegates recommendations. They made eight recommendations for the Department of Environment, Climate and Communications to consider. These are outlined below:
