

## **Decision on Specific Prospecting Activities**

The Minister has assessed the exploration project proposed by the company and has determined that the activities are not likely to have a significant effect on the environment.

Company	BMEx Pty Ltd
Activity	Drilling in an area of 0.093km <sup>2</sup> in the northern portion of PLA 1803.
Environmental Considerations	The drilling area is located approximately 1.9km from the nearest Natura 2000 Site (Lough Ree SAC), approximately 1.6km from the nearest Natural Heritage Area (Forthill Bog) and approximately 1.3km from the nearest proposed Natural Heritage Areas (Lough Slawn). The company is using small volumes of treated stream water for drilling purposes. All drilling water will be re-circulated. Any drilling additives or greases used will be non-hazardous, non-toxic and biodegradable. The drilling is not likely to have a significant effect on the environment.
