Qualifications

1 Character

Candidates shall be of good character.

2 Health

Candidates shall be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

3 Education, Training, Experience, Etc.

Candidates shall:

- a hold an honours degree (level 8 in the National Framework of Qualifications) in Engineering;
- b have at least nine years satisfactory experience of engineering work, including a period of not less than seven years satisfactory experience in the direction and supervision of major engineering work;
- c possess a high standard of technical training and experience and of administrative experience;
- d have satisfactory experience at strategic management level; and
- e have a satisfactory knowledge of public service organisation.

In exercise of the functions conferred on the Minister for Housing, Planning, Community and Local Government by section 160 of the Local Government Act, 2001 (No. 37 of 2001), which said functions have been delegated to me by the said Minister by virtue of section 236(7) of the said Act, I, Mary Hurley, Assistant Secretary, Department of Housing, Planning, Community and Local Government, hereby declare the foregoing to be the Qualifications for County Engineer.
