Qualifications

1. Character

Each candidate must be of good character.

2. Health

Each candidate must be in a state of health such as would indicate a reasonable prospect of ability to render regular and efficient service.

3. Education, Training, Experience etc.

Each candidate must, on the latest date for receipt of completed application forms:

- (i) hold an honours degree (level 8 on the National Framework of Qualifications) in Engineering;
- (ii) have had at least eight years satisfactory relevant engineering experience including a period of not less than six years' satisfactory experience in the direction and supervision of major engineering work;
- (iii) possess a high standard of technical training and experience and of administrative experience;
- (iv) have satisfactory experience at strategic management level; and
- (v) have satisfactory knowledge of public service organisation.
