Performance Delivery Agreement 2021

1. Background and Context

1.1 Objectives of this Agreement

The purpose of this Agreement is to define, in the context of the resource inputs provided, the targets by which the performance of the Probation Service will be measured in 2021. The ongoing supports that the Department of Justice will provide to the Probation Service in this regard, and the mechanisms for monitoring and appraising performance, form part of the overall governance arrangements between the two parties and as such are set out in the separate but complementary Oversight Agreement 2020-22.

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2.3 Principal risks to achievement of targets

The main potential risks to achievement of the targets set out in this Agreement, and the corresponding mitigation measures that have been or will be put in place, are set out below.

Failure to meet statutory obligations under Community Service legislation and failure to address backlog of Community Service Orders due to COVID 19 pandemic.	Working Group established to review operation of Community Service.
	Communication with key stakeholders including judiciary.
	Availability of Integrated Community Service nationally.
Failure to develop and futureproof a 'fit for purpose' case management system could adversely impact on service delivery and compliance with data management strategies and data interoperability.	Procedures in place to develop fixes to ensure the ongoing operability of case tracking system (CTS) overseen by the Business Process Group, which meets on a quarterly basis. Business Support and Development Director liaising with DoJ IM&T on the development of a new CTS.
Failure to have adequate processes and resources in place for the new statutory Parole Board resulting in failure to meet legislative requirements.	Probation Service a member of DoJ Implementation Group. Bilateral engagement with stakeholders including the DoJ and IPS.
