Below are a number of supports which are currently available to service providers seeking advice and guidance on operating during this time:

Dedicated Public Health Helpline for ELC/SAC Services (HSE)

HSE Public Health operate a dedicated helpline for ELC/SAC services that provides support for services with a confirmed case of COVID-19. You can access the helpline on **01-5119777**.

National Covid-19 Out of Hours Helpline

This helpline provides weekend support to ELC and SAC services including childminders who have a suspected or confirmed case of Covid-19 in their service and is operated by the City and County Childcare Committees (CCCs). The helpline operates on Saturday, Sunday and Bank holidays from 10am to 1pm and 1.30 to 4pm. You can access the helpline on **1800 940341**.
