We refer to the above referenced application and your email dated 13/04/2022 in respect of observations/recommendations received from the prescribed bodies consultation submissions. We have reviewed the observations and recommendations from each of the prescribed bodies.

Inland Fisheries Ireland (IFI)

We note that IFI are happy for the application to go ahead with the condition for the biosecurity procedures outlined to be followed when moving between sites and to notify IFI one week in advance of field work taking place. We will ensure this happens.

Sea Fisheries Protection Agency (SFPA)

We note there are no objections or comments from SFPA.

Marine Institute (MI)

We note that the MI has no objections to the granting of what it considers a trivial activity.

Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine (DAFM)

We note the Department has no objection to the granting of the licences.

Marine Survey Office (MSO)

We note that the MSO has no objection to the proposed works in the Application referenced from a navigational safety perspective.

Underwater Archaeology Unit (UAU)

We note the UAU have no comment to make on this application.

Marine Advisor Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage (DHLGH)
