APPLICATION FOR A FORESHORE LEASE/LICENCE

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 19 of the Foreshore Act, 1933 that Dr Grace Cott and Ms. Shannon Burke of University College Dublin have applied to the Minister of Housing, Local Government and Heritage for a Foreshore licence under Section 3(3) of the said Act.

The proposed activities intend to be conducted in the following saltmarsh sites to facilitate the analysis of Irish coastal wetland carbon stocks. This includes the removal of soil samples (16 soil samples - 6cm wide and 1m deep) and quadrats of vegetation (30 x 30cm).
