## **Bovine TB Herd History Risk Statement and Report**

Dear HERD KEEPER,

In the context of bovine TB eradication, research has shown that the risk of a future TB breakdown can last for up to 10 years after an initial breakdown. The risk of a future breakdown decreases as time progresses.

### **Your herd history risk is C0 (2)**

**C** - indicates that your herd is clear of TB on date of generation of this statement.

**0** - indicates that your herd has been clear of TB for less than 12 months.

**(2)** - indicates that your herd has had 2 TB breakdowns in the last 10 years

All herds do not have the same risk of a future TB breakdown. Much of this risk is based on the following;

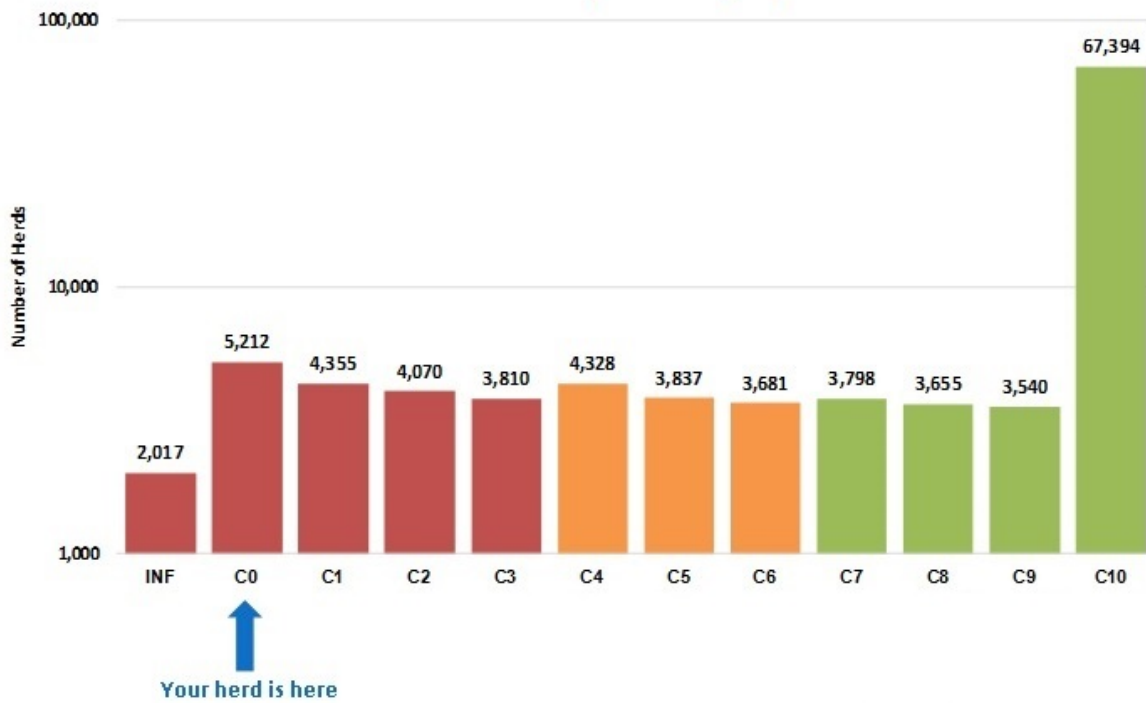
- how long it is since your herd last had a breakdown,
- how severe that breakdown was,
- at risk animals in your herd,
- your purchasing history.

This report provides information about your purchasing pattern from herds within different risk categories. It also details the animals within your herd which are at a greater risk of testing positive for TB in the future. This information is correct at the generation of this statement.

**To minimise the chances of your herd developing TB you should consider very carefully the TB risk of herds you purchase animals from - particularly breeding stock, including stock bulls. The longer a herd you buy from has been free of TB, the less likely it is that your herd will go down with TB from this source. 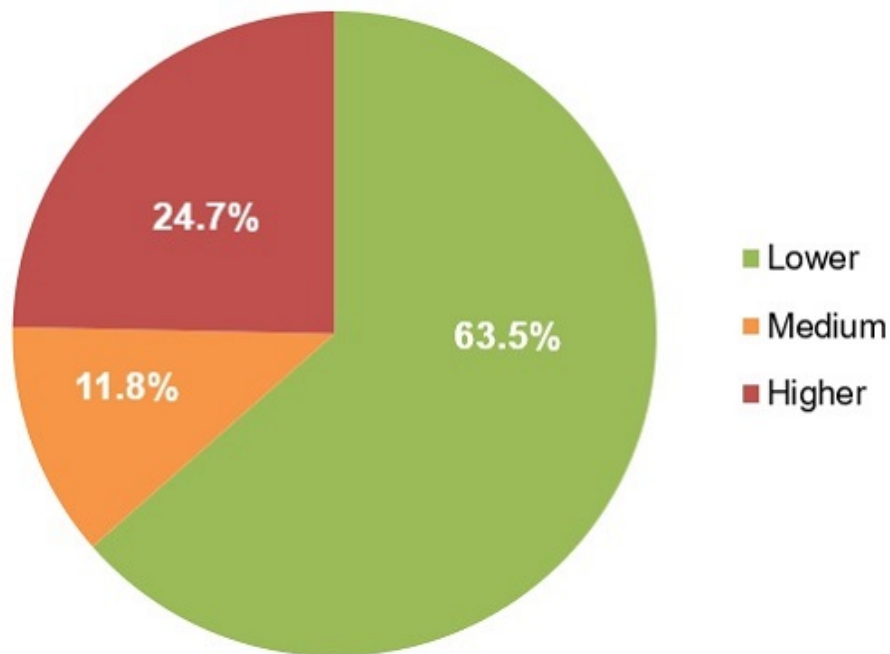
